- ILEX President's Medal

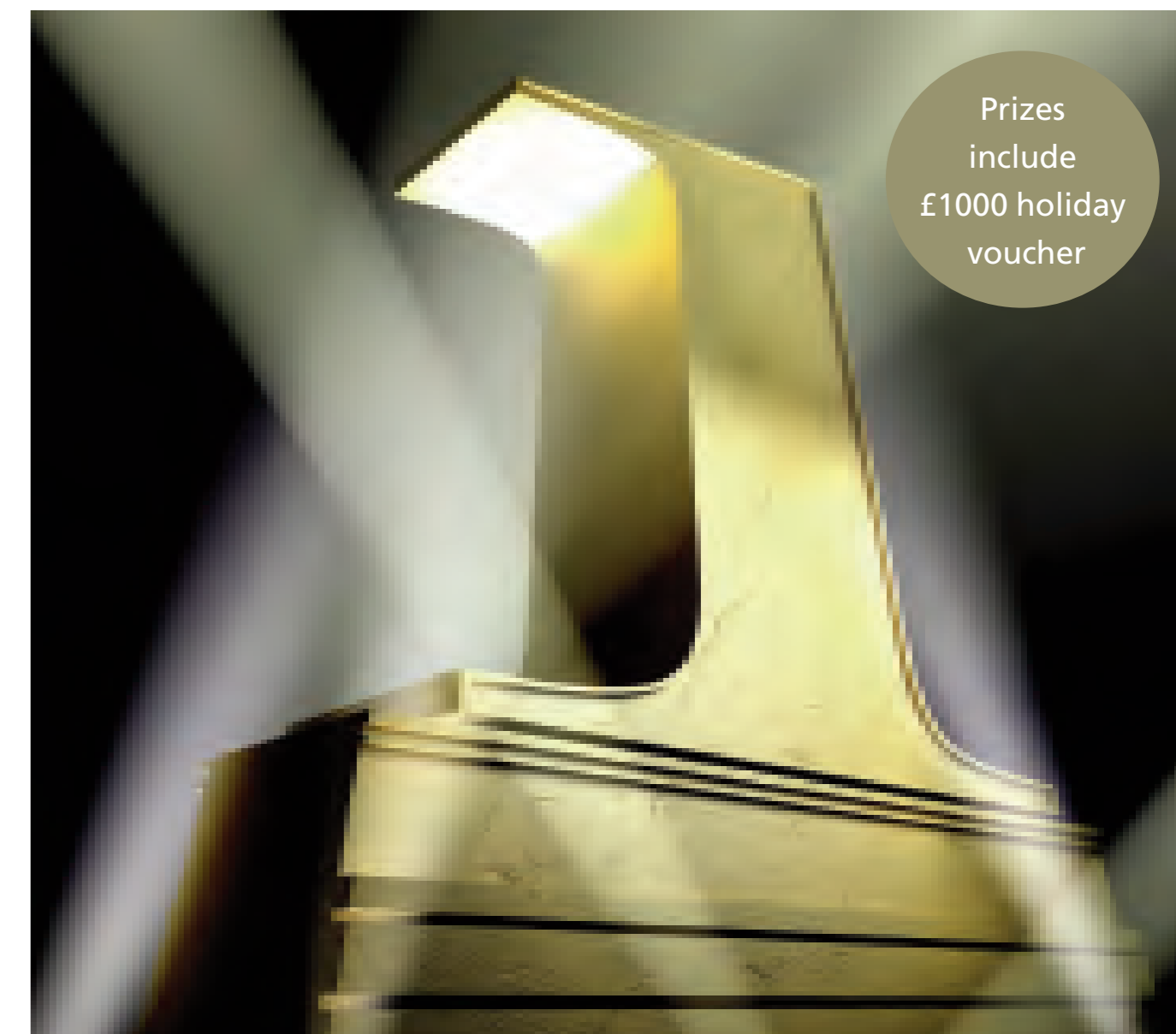
### Rules of Entry

- There is no fee to enter.
- Individuals may nominate themselves, but entries must be endorsed by the nominee's employer. Self-employed Fellows are eligible to enter provided that their nomination is made by a professional colleague.
- Employees of the sponsors, ILEX, ITC, IPS, or members of their Boards or Councils are not eligible to enter.
- All entries must be no more than 750 words.
- All nominees must be registered, fully paid up members of ILEX. Please include the name of the nominee on each sheet of paper.
- Nominations for the Pro Bono Medal: members can nominate themselves for the award, but the name and address of an independent reference must be provided. The reference must be in a position to comment on the nominee's voluntary work.
- In the case of the ILEX Employer of the Year medal, the nominator must be a registered, fully paid up member of ILEX. For the nominee, please put forward the name and contact details of a representative of the employer who will collect the medal at the ceremony. For example, this could be a partner, Training Manager/HR representative, head of department or the member's boss.
- All entries will be treated as confidential.
- The judge's decision is binding and final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- No alternative for prizes will be given.
- The deadline for receipt of entries is 9am on Monday 29th March 2010. Late entries will not be accepted.
- The Medals will be presented at the ILEX Graduation Ceremony, to be held on 19th and 20th April 2010 at the Bedford Corn Exchange. Winners will be given prior notification. Reasonable UK travel costs for each winner and their nominee to attend the ceremony will be met by ILEX. In the event that the Graduation Ceremony is only held on one day, the medals will be presented on 19th April.

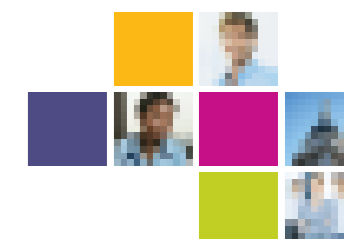
