The Medal:

The ILEX Pro Bono Medal recognises the dedication of ILEX members who offer their expertise on a Pro Bono basis.

The medal will be presented to an outstanding practising individual who, in addition to their daily work, has given generously of their time without charge to charities, to Pro Bono legal help groups, voluntary organisations or the underprivileged; or who has undertaken difficult or socially or morally important cases without charge.

Judges will be looking for nominations for an individual who is committed to, and can demonstrate, excellent Pro Bono work.

The Prize:

The winner will receive a commemorative trophy, certificate and a cheque for £750 to be donated to a charity of the winner's choice, courtesy of sponsor The Peverel Group.

The Ceremony:

The medal will be presented at the gala ILEX Presidential Luncheon to be held on 3rd June 2010 at Clothworkers Hall, London. The winner will have the opportunity to mingle with Parliamentarians and leading names from across the legal sector at a champagne reception, followed by a three-course lunch at this glamorous location.

- No alternative for prizes will be given.
- The deadline for receipt of entries is 9am on Friday 14th May 2010. Late entries will not be accepted.
- The Medals will be presented at the gala ILEX Presidential Luncheon to be held on 3rd June 2010 at Clothworkers Hall, London. Winners will be given prior notification. Reasonable UK travel costs for each winner and their nominee to attend the ceremony will be met by ILEX.
