

## Arrangements for students completing their existing ILEX Level 6 Higher Professional Diploma in Law using units from ILEX's new Level 6 suite of units

These arrangements apply:

- 1) When a student has already achieved a subject/some subjects towards the existing ILEX Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law, but has not yet achieved all subjects of the qualification;
- 2) When a student has not achieved the required subjects to complete the ILEX Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law by the last examination session before this qualification is withdrawn, ie October 2009.

A student finding themselves in the above situation must, in order to complete their ILEX Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law, adhere to the following criteria:

- A student can only complete their ILEX Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law by using an equivalent unit from the new Level 6 suite of units;
- A student must use the table below to identify the required unit equivalent for a specific subject and must successfully complete that unit.

**Notes: -**

1) The following subjects from the current ILEX Level 6 Professional Higher Diploma in Law have no equivalent in the new qualification, and, hence, cannot be achieved through achievement of a new Level 6 unit:

Law of Intellectual Property (Paper 20)  
Commercial Law (Paper 25)  
Law of Evidence (Paper 28)  
Social Welfare Law (Paper 30)  
Local Government Law (Paper 31)

2) Candidates are reminded that whilst there is often a strong overlap of content between new units and old subjects, there are also sometimes important differences where a unit may have been updated or simply addressed a new area of topics. Candidates need to be mindful of this potential and build this consideration into their study.

3) The above arrangements will apply until **October 2013** at which time ILEX will reserve the right to refuse requests for claims against the old subjects.

4) All new ILEX units undertaken by candidates in order to complete their existing qualification will be automatically processed by ILEX to award the candidate their qualification. Candidates will not be required to manually claim an existing Level 6 qualification award upon completion of a new Level 6 unit or units.
